On 03/11/04 Victim Michelle Newland came to CCPD and filed a violation of injunction report on Suspect Gregory Scott Goodyear.

Victim Newland stated that on 12/16/04 she obtained an injunction for protection from her ex-boyfriend Gregory Scott Goodyear. On 02/04/04 Suspect Goodyear began to contact Victim Newland via email. Between 02/04/04 and 03/11/04 Victim Newland received 181 emails. These emails originated from a screen-name of Devin Bazar. The content of these messages left no doubt in Victim Newland's mind that they came from Suspect Goodyear. In addition, eighteen (18) handwritten messages were left on Victim Newland's vehicle. These messages appeared on her vehicle at home, work and while grocery shopping. Lastly, two (2) cassette tapes were left at Victim Newland's residence. Victim Newland completed a sworn written statement and provided the 181 emails, the eighteen (18) handwritten notes and cassette tapes as evidence. This evidence was entered into CCPD evidence.

On 03/16/04 contact was made with Witness Devin Bazar. Witness Bazar is Suspect Goodyear's current roommate. Witness Bazar came to CCPD and provided a sworn taped statement. Witness Bazar stated that he was aware that Suspect Goodyear had used his computer and email address to contact Michele Newland. Witness Bazar further stated he was aware that an injunction preventing Suspect Goodyear from contacting Victim Newland was in effect.

On 03/16/04 at approximately 5:00 pm, contact was made with Suspect Goodyear via telephone by Officer Minnillo. During the conversation Suspect Goodyear told Officer Minnillo that he had contacted Victim Newland...in violation of his court order. Suspect Goodyear stated that he needed to make arrangements for his minor daughter and that he would turn himself in to CCPD on 03/17/04 at 1:00 pm. Suspect Goodyear failed to show.

On 05/28/04 at approximately 1; 00 pm, Suspect Goodyear arrived at the CCPD to gain information regarding his case. At that time Suspect Goodyear was taken into custody and placed under arrest by Officer Minnillo.

Suspect Goodyear was booked at CCPD. Suspect Goodyear was given his Miranda Warnings at which time he waived those rights and proceeded to give a taped recorded confession. Subject Goodyear stated that he did send Victim Newland, over 180 Emails, 2 tapes and notes on her vehicle and was aware he was in violation of a valid injunction.

The taped confession and a CD from Goodyear were placed into CCPD evidence. Goodyear was transported to Lee county Jail without incident.
